PURPOSE: To permit clearly superior students who have good knowledge of the course material to get credit for a course without taking it. A student who is enrolled in the course or who has already taken it may not take the proficiency exam. **An exam may be taken only once.**

GRADE: The assigned grade is Pass or Fail. To pass the exam an A or B must be made. Failures are not formally reported.
